By submitting this application you agree to and promise to abide by the following terms and or conditions.

It is the sole responsibility of all vendors and or merchants to comply with the laws and statues affecting the sale and distribution of all materials for resale in the Commonwealth of Kentucky including but not limited to general merchandise, food products or items regulated and or taxable through the Kentucky Revenue Department. The collection and payment of the appropriate sales tax is the responsibility of each firm or individual and not that of the Stonewall Picnic & Pride Festival, the RSBP association, its board members or any of its sponsors.

It is further the responsibility of the participant to provide adequate event insurance and to hold from harm the RSBP organization , its board members and or its sponsors due to loss of personal property, personal injury or defamation due to or caused by their participation in the festival. Participation in this event does not imply that you or anyone of your firm is Gay or Lesbian but that you do support our effort to provide a positive image to the population at large.

Individuals and or companies who's sole purpose of setting up at this event is to provide food service must meet the requirements of the Christian County Health Department and may be required to purchase an additional permit. We advise you to check with the governing authority on the requirements for your particular booth. Food and beverage items, including but not limited to soft drinks, juices, bottled water or any other prepared or cooked foods may only be sold through approved food vendors.

The vendor hereby acknowledges its responsibility and liability, and agrees to compensate RSBP for any damages or loss caused by, including but not limited to, it's representatives, agents, employees, volunteers, members, vehicles, equipment, materials and objects to the environs and infrastructure of Trail of Tears Commemorative Park which causes RSBP to repair, pay or reimburse the Trail of Tears Commission or the Commonwealth of Kentucky due to damages caused to the Park grounds or its facilities. Trash removal and clean up of the rented space is the responsibility of each participant.

The participant understands that at all time the Stonewall Picnic & Pride Festival is a family event and as such agrees not to display, offer for view or for sale any item(s) that may be offensive, sexually explicit, pronomographic, classified as obscene or contraband. Nor shal a vendor disply and or sell any item or items that may be illegal copies or reproductions or interpretations of licensed products.

Booths classified as informational or non-profit may not display or offer for sale any item or items beyond that of an approved raffle or fund raiser. These booths may however freely distribute printed or promotional materials promoting their group and or objectives which are free of charge to thier clients and the festival visitors.
